All of these vendors are raising money for nonprofit organizations or scholarships. Rain date: July 4.

7:00pm to 9:00pm - Hank Whitsett Band will play on the Stonington Pier for your listening and dancing pleasure.

9:00pm - Fireworks! This is the best place to watch the show out over the Stonington harbor. Rain date: July 4.
